S. R. O. No. 422/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 565 and 407 of the Kerala Municipality Act, 1994 (20 2of 1994) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules, to amend the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, issued under G. O. (P) No. 11/2018/LSGD, dated 15th February, 2018, and published as S. R. O. No. 95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 407, dated 20th February, 2018, namely:—

#### RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These Rules may be called the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Amendment Rules, 2018.
- (2) They shall be deemed to have come in to force on the 20th day of February, 2018.
- 2. Amendment to the rules.—In the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), for the word "ninety", the words "two hundred and seventy" shall be substituted.

### **Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G. O. (P) No. 11/2018/LSGD, dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S. R. O. No. 95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 407 dated 20th February, 2018, the time-limit for filing the application for regularisation had been 90 days. The said time-limit expired on 20th May, 2018. Government have, therefore, decided to extend the time-limit up to 16th November, 2018, so as to provide an opportunity to those who could not file application in time.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
